SUBJECT: The James River Commerce Center Operating Expense Account

The Economic Development Authority (EDA) budget includes the James River Commerce Center (JRCC) Operating Expense account, with \$25,000 approved for FY 18 Business Assistance, \$25,000 approved for FY 18 and Newport News/Williamsburg International Airport Funding (RAISE), with \$26,804 approved for FY 18.

Business Assistance funds were used in previous years for the Google 360 Grant program, scholarships for small businesses to participate in the JunipHER business acceleration program and the website development/e-commerce grant program. For FY 18 the Business Assistance funds have not been allocated for any specific program. RAISE was approved in the budget, but has been suspended at the direction of the Board of Supervisors since FY 17. With the EDA no longer participating in RAISE, staff is proposing funds from both Business Assistance and RAISE accounts be reallocated.

Expenses related to the EDA parcel in the JRCC include \$10,000 (already approved for FY 18) for wetland delineation and confirmation of wetlands by the Army Corps of Engineers. That work is in progress, leading to an application for a Land Disturbing Permit to complete construction of a shell building in accordance with the approved site plan, which expires in July 2020. The next steps include:

- The Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) wetlands permit for the shell building site (application fee \$600);
- Mitigation for impacts to wetlands, due to construction per the approved plan (the purchase of credits from a mitigation bank have been estimated at \$6,500);
- E&S Bonds (the fee is being calculated for purposes of preparing a project budget);
- Site work and construction of the shell or build-to-suit building (not yet estimated and could be a public-private partnership);
- Cleanup and mowing of the southern portion of the site (estimated at \$40,248, as previously discussed by the EDA); and
- Wetland delineation, confirmation, permitting, engineering and other costs associated with the development of the southern portion of the EDA site and/or the sites recently acquired from the Colonial Williamsburg Foundation.

The DEQ wetland permit for the norther portion and cleanup and mowing of the southern portion of the site are targeted for FY 18. Additionally, dues to the owner's association are due in FY 18.

Staff recommends a budget reallocation of \$21,804 to the James River Commerce Center Operating Expense account from the RAISE account and \$20,000 to the James River Commerce Center Operating Expense account from the Business Assistance account. This will result in \$5,000 remaining in each of the RAISE and Business Assistance accounts.

TO THE JAMES RIVER COMMERCE CENTER OPERATING EXPENSE

- WHEREAS, the Economic Development Authority (EDA) of James City County, has been asked to pay the James River Commerce Center Annual Dues for Parcel 6 and Parcel 11, located at 1716 Endeavor Drive and 8915 Columbia Drive; and,
- WHEREAS, Parcel 6 and Parcel 11 were recently acquired by James City County; and,
- WHEREAS, the EDA had previously budgeted for the Annual Dues for the EDA-owned parcel at 8925 Columbia Drive in the James River Commerce Center Operating Expense line item; and
- WHEREAS, at the January 11, 2018 EDA meeting, the EDA reviewed a contract to perform site cleaning work; and
- WHEREAS, the EDA unanimously agreed to proceed with site cleanup of approximately 29 acres of the parcel south of Columbia Drive; and
- WHEREAS, the EDA desires to transfer \$20,000 from the Business Assistance line item to the James River Commerce Center Operating Expense line item; and
- WHEREAS, the EDA desires to transfer \$21,804 from the Newport News/Williamsburg International Airport Funding (RAISE) line item to the James River Commerce Center Operating Expense line item.
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Economic Development Authority of James City County, Virginia, hereby amends the FY 2018 budget to transfer \$20,000 from the "Business Assistance" line item to "James River Commerce Center Operating Expense" line item; and
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Economic Development Authority of James City County, Virginia, hereby amends the FY 2018 budget to transfer \$21,804 from the RAISE line item to the James River Commerce Center Operating Expense line item.
